In **1991** she got, as external candidate in Pescara, her Diploma in flute «summa cum laude».

In **1993** she gained a specialization Diploma at "Accademia Italiana del Flauto" (Rome). The course was conducted by M° Raymond Guiot. Giuseppina Ledda was awarded the first prize.

In **1994** she graduated with full score at the "*Hochschule für Musik*" in Vienna. The course was conducted by M° Wolfgang Schulz.

In **2005**, she gained a specialization Diploma at "Accademia di Alta Formazione Artistica e Musicale «Lorenzo Perosi» di Biella". The course was conducted by M° Peter-Lukas Graf.

She participated in a lot of national and international music competitions, obtaining the following prizes: 3<sup>rd</sup> prize at "Concorso nazionale di Flauto Ennio Porrino", Cat. "Non diplomati" (Cagliari, December 1988); 2<sup>nd</sup> prize -first prize not awarded- at "Concorso nazionale V. Galilei", sez. Flauto, cat. B (Firenze, march 1989); 1<sup>st</sup> prize at "Concorso di esecuzione strumentale Città di Chieti", sez. Flauto, cat. C (Chieti, October 1989); 1<sup>st</sup> prize at "Concorso internazionale di musica Carlo Soliva", sez. Flauto. Absolute winner, in duo with piano, of the Special Prize "Carlo Soliva", Chamber music (Casale Monferrato, 1990); "Premio Calpurnia" at "Festival delle Nazioni di Musica da Camera" (Città di Castello, 1991); 2<sup>nd</sup> prize "ex aequo" -first prize not awarded- at "Concorso Nazionale di flauto Giulio Briccialdi" (Terni, 1992).

She played in a lot of chamber music groups, and in orchestras: *Istituzione Sinfonica Abruzzese*, *International Chamber Ensemble*, *Teatro dell'Opera di Roma*, *Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia*.
